I have a full series of videos in my Hair Transplant Education section of my Youtube channel that discusses facts about hair transplant surgery and I do not discuss or mention any clinics I work with in these videos unless they have provided content that helps me with the video. I believe there is only one video where this is noted. These videos are intended to be clinic neutral. The single video I can recall where I do in fact discuss clinics is the video linked above, "Celebrity Hair Transplant Disasters: The Kyle Christie Effect". I mentioned clinics I do worth with and showed their examples of natural hairlines. I also specifically mentioned clinics I do NOT work with, but still provide excellent results, in order to preserve balance and an unbiased overview. I hope this makes things more clear as I try to be incredibly fair in my presentations.

As I mentioned in my previous post, I do not know much more about HLC than the average patient. This is because they have not applied for membership. If one has not applied, I cannot investigate them deeper because I require information that is not publicly available. I also stated that what I see of their work, looks quite good. This proves that I only compliment clinics that I have a relationship with. I compliment other clinics when they deserve to be complimented, regardless of my affiliation.
